

Leading in Faith

Session Meeting Notes

During the November 17th Session meeting the following items were covered:

- Pastor Don and Norman McElwain reported on the Donegal Presbytery meeting they attended (via Zoom) earlier in the day. They noted that the Presbytery budget for 2021 was approved and that churches in the Presbytery are being encouraged to suspend in-sanctuary services through Lent due to the increase in Covid-19 cases. The Presbytery is producing a "Lessons & Carols" taped service that will be available to churches. It was agreed to utilize that service on Sunday, December 27th.
- Deb Lannon reported that, even though we did not have church in-person for several months, our level of giving is equal to last year, and that many members have given via the electronic funds transfer option provided on our website. Reed Anderson reported that Centre has been named a recipient of a generous monetary gift from the estate of Betty Lou Lowe Tucker.
- A report from the Manse Committee on the status of the repairs was received.
- Kathleen Wilson reported for the Nominating Committee that the slate of officers for 2021 will be: Deacon—Patricia McElwain and Trustee—Robert McElwain. Election of officers will be held following worship on December 13th. More information on how voting will be conducted remotely will be announced.
- Don Wilson and Pastor Don provided an update on the use of the new equipment and software when livestreaming Sunday services. The quality of the broadcast continues to improve.
- Presbytery of Donegal Executor Rev. Dr. Erin Cox-Holmes and Stated Clerk Rev. Dr. Michael Wilson, met with
 the Session to review the steps in launching the search for a new minister. It was determined that we would
 prefer to work toward finding an installed pastor rather than a transitional pastor, and that we would prefer for
 the new pastor to live in the manse, but that could be negotiable. It was agreed that Pastor Don's involvement
 in the search process would be welcome and appreciated. The first step will be to conduct a survey to Centre's
 members and for the Nominating Committee to begin consideration of names of people to be part of the Pastor
 Nominating Committee (Search Committee).

Trustees' Update

On Wednesday, November 18 Bob Stewart fixed the slate on the church's carriage entrance. He replaced some slates and tightened several more. Later, he will check over the entire church roof for any needed slate work.

On Tuesday, November 18, the Trustees had a work party in the office of the manse. The false ceiling, the original ceiling, and all the paneling were removed. They also removed a large pile of wood and other debris from the basement. A new dehumidifier has been installed in the basement. Thank you to everyone who helped with this not-so-pleasant job.



Calling a Pastor

With the retirement of Pastor Don Hackett set to begin in July, 2021, our pastoral search process has begun. Here is what has been accomplished thus far and our steps to come:

Steps in the Pastoral Search Process

Session Responsibilities

- In Oct. 2020, <u>Session approved the retirement</u> of Pastor Hackett to commence on July 1, 2021.
- In Nov. 2020, the <u>Donegal Presbytery Executive Presbyter and Stated Clerk visited</u> Session to review the steps of the call process.
- In Nov. 2020, our Session voted to begin the process to search for a full time, installed pastor.
- In Dec. 2020, our Session <u>will conduct a survey of our members to help determine the future</u> direction of our church mission and leadership.
- In Dec. 2020, our <u>Personnel Committee and Treasurer will prepare</u> a financial review, pastor position description, pastor search budget, compensation package range, and other documents for Session and the Presbytery Committee on Ministry (COM) review and approval.
- The <u>Nominating Committee will seek recommendations</u> for the Pastor Nominating Committee to present to the congregation for approval in early 2021.

Pastor Nominating Committee (PNC)

- Presbytery will coach the PNC in how to proceed.
- PNC will prepare a Ministry Information Form (MIF) to be approved by Session and COM.
- PNC will <u>advertise the position, receive resumes, interview candidates, select</u> a candidate for vote, and present the terms of call to Session for approval.
- The candidate will be <u>introduced to the congregation</u> in various ways.
- A <u>congregational meeting</u> will be held to meet and approve the candidate.
- PNC will oversee the welcome and ongoing support of the approved candidate.

Please be praying for wisdom as we discern our direction and leadership for the future. We need you to **participate in the congregational survey** that will be coming soon!
